### **GEOG 160 Physical Geography II: Geology, Geomorphology and Soils**

3 Credits

Geography 160 is the second half of an introductory course in physical geography. Subjects covered in this term include landforms, weathering, mass movement, plate tectonics, igneous processes, glaciers, river systems, coastal processes and soils. Laboratories will include rock and mineral identification, plate tectonics, topographical and airphoto interpretation of landforms, hydrological measurement, landslide assessment, and identification of coastal landforms.
